



Friday 17th June

This week's activities have been based on the story Tyrannosaurus Drip, a fantastic rhyming adventure story that celebrates differences. Rhyming is important for helping children develop language and literacy skills, and to notice and work with sounds within words. Developing literacy skills begins with listening and verbalising rather than reading and writing. This week the children have listened to rhyming stories and matched rhyming words using picture cards.

We have enjoyed lots of messy play as dinosaurs and slime, mud or water seem to go together very well! The children practiced their scissor skills with spaghetti in the tuff tray. David put a big handful on a dinosaurs head and then gave him a very smart haircut!

A large group of our children love to do experiments, so during a Wild Learning session we investigated mixing sand, bicarbonate of soda and vinegar. When asked what an experiment was Alfie told us "Experiment means you see what happens". That's right Alfie – Well done! We loved adding the green sand to make colourful fizzing cups! The children have even suggested adding salt or crisps at our next Science Session. We are looking forward to hearing
