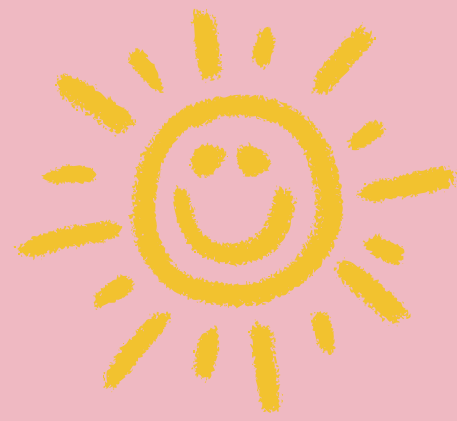
There was lots of creativity as we worked together on the floor to draw a beautiful spring time garden, following a step-by-step guide to create our own flowers.
