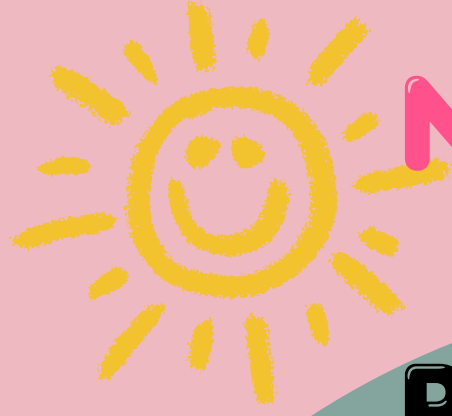

RAINBOWS ROOM:



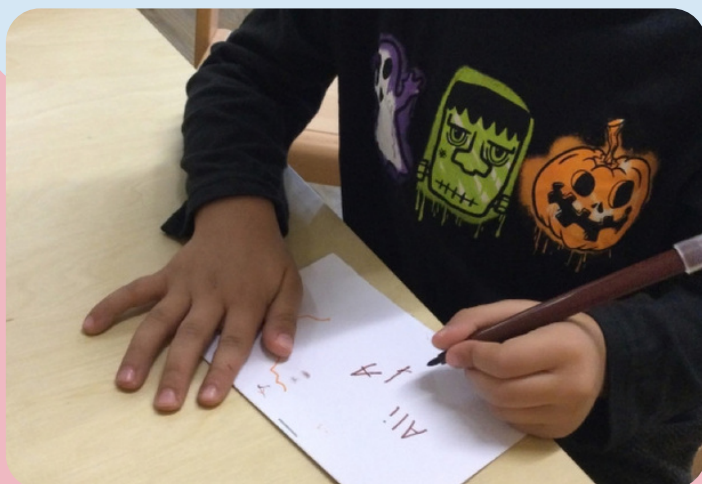
This week, our main focus has been helping the children settle into Rainbows Room, become familiar with their new environment and learn the daily routines. It has been lovely to see them growing in confidence and beginning to feel comfortable and secure.

Alongside this, the children have enjoyed lots of learning through play. Creative and sensory activities have included floor drawing, string painting, mosaics, our bubbly brick wash and puzzle hunt. We've also explored early maths through counting, threading and Numicon.

There have been plenty of opportunities for physical development through obstacle courses, ball and ramp investigations and outdoor challenges. Building with Duplo and K'NEX, making storybooks and imaginative play in the outdoor kitchen have encouraged creativity, problem-solving and communication.

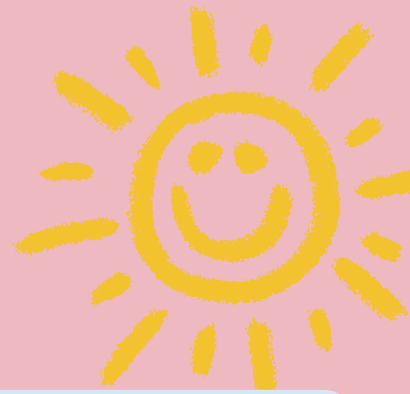
During circle time, we've been developing listening, turn-taking and name recognition through stories and familiar games.

This week, Sunbeams have continued their 'All About Me' theme, focusing on emotions through The Colour Monster. The children are continuing to settle well, becoming familiar with routines, forming new friendships and growing in confidence within the room.

We've explored emotions through stories, sensory water play and creative activities, talking about different facial expressions and feelings. The children have also enjoyed painting, play dough, collage and mark making, developing their creativity and fine motor skills.

There has been some fantastic teamwork and problem-solving, particularly while exploring our cardboard box houses and during outdoor water play. Music and movement has also been a favourite, encouraging listening, following instructions and moving in different ways.

Outdoors, the children have been developing their physical confidence through climbing, running, ball games and imaginative play. A lovely week of exploring emotions, building friendships and becoming increasingly confident in Sunbeams!
