



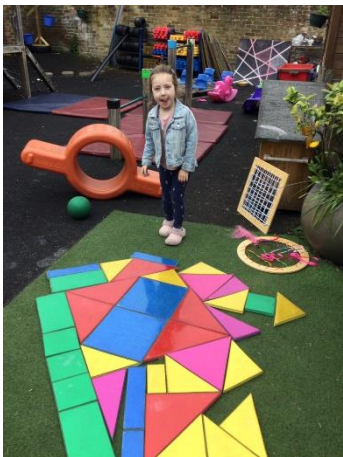
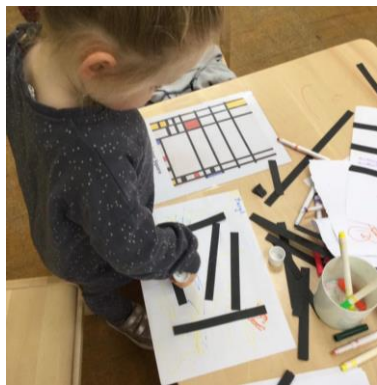
Newsletter Friday 24th May 2024
