

Dear Parent and carers,

We have had a lovely week settling into new routines, finding out about each other and making friends. Our learning has been linked to 'All About Me' with lots of activities about our bodies, families and home. The children have drawn themselves and their families, learnt about different emotions, used shaving foam to build towers, got smelly with herbs and role-played hospitals with their friends. Our giant models of teeth are great at teaching children how to brush their teeth properly. In maths, the children drew around their shoes and used small cubes to measure the length and then using giant Lego to measure how tall they are. This is the phase before using cms to form an understanding that an amount of something represents a length. E.g. my shoe is 7 cubes long/my shoe is 7cm long. Using playdough, the children made cakes and counted the candles and made Birthday cards with different numbers on the front. Next week our topic is 'Friendship' and we would like the children to bring a Teddy to preschool on **Thursday** for a Teddy Bear Picnic.
