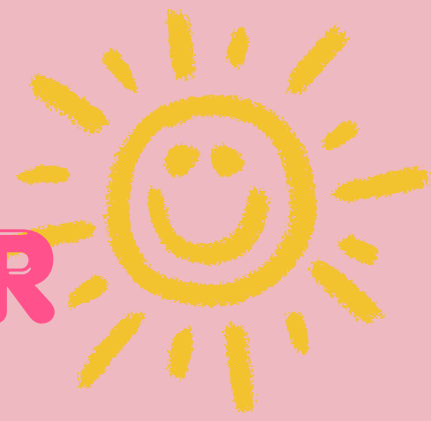

One of our favourite activities has been making bears using different materials. The children showed great creativity and imagination while developing their fine motor skills through cutting, sticking, and assembling their own bears.

We also had lots of fun making “porridge” in our sensory play area. The children explored textures, mixing, and pretend play, engaging their senses while building language skills as they described what they were doing. The children also absolutely loved our Goldilocks-themed role play area, where they acted out the story, took on different characters, and used their imagination to retell events in their own way.
