# RAINBOWS' NEWSLETTER



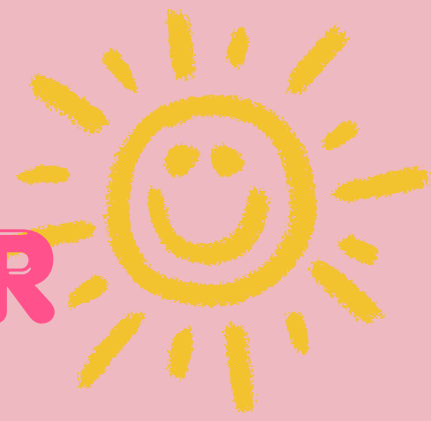
## RAINBOWS ROOM:

The Rainbows Room had a fantastic time celebrating Science Week, taking part in different experiments and investigations each day. One of our favourite activities was bubble painting. The children used straws to blow bubbles into colourful paint and then gently placed paper on top to create beautiful bubble prints. It was exciting to watch the bubbles pop and leave interesting patterns behind. We also carried out a fun experiment using lemonade, water and raisins. The children observed closely to see what would happen when the raisins were placed into the different liquids, noticing how the bubbles in the lemonade made the raisins move up and down. Another activity involved drawing around our bodies. The children worked together to trace around their friends on large pieces of paper and then decorated the outlines, learning more about their bodies while enjoying some creative fun. It has been a wonderful week full of curiosity, exploration and hands-on learning as the children discovered new and exciting ways to explore science together.

## SUNBEAMS ROOM:

This week in the Sunbeams Room we celebrated Science Week with lots of exciting hands-on experiments and discoveries.

Our bubble play was a big hit! The children had great fun learning. Another activity involved putting water on pieces of cardboard and observing what happened over time. The children watched closely as the water slowly evaporated, learning that water can disappear into the air.

One of the highlights of the week was our volcano experiment. The children gathered around and watched with great curiosity as the mixture bubbled and fizzed, just like a real volcano erupting. There were lots of “wows” and excited reactions as the volcano came to life!

It has been a fantastic week full of exploration, curiosity, and scientific discovery. The children showed great interest in asking questions, making observations, and learning about the world around them.
