Dear Parents and Carers.

This week, our theme has been Construction and what a creative, hands-on week it's been! The children have had plenty of opportunities to build using a wide range of open-ended materials, from wooden blocks and crates to recycled items and loose parts to constructions sets like Mobilo and stickle bricks.

Open-ended construction play is a wonderful part of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), supporting so many areas of learning and development. It encourages problem-solving, teamwork, creativity and resilience. As children plan and build, they're also developing early maths skills like counting, measuring, balancing and comparing shapes and sizes. It's been fantastic to see the children's imaginations come to life. Some built towering structures, others made long roads or bridges that travelled around the room. Many proudly shared their creations and worked together to bring their ideas to life. There was a real sense of achievement in their play — and plenty of fun along the way!

Construction play also helps to build confidence, resilience, and communication skills as children explain their ideas and test them out. These are all transferable skills for school and life beyond. We've loved watching their curiosity and creativity shine through this week!

This week, our school leavers have begun practising their special graduation songs! We're keeping rehearsals short and sweet, just 10-minute sessions, to help the children stay focused, engaged and excited.

At The Children's Workshop, we believe that early years should be full of active play and meaningful learning. That's why we don't do big, formal performances. Instead, we've chosen a few simple songs for the children to enjoy and confidently share during graduation. This approach is developmentally appropriate for our 3- and 4-year-olds and helps make the experience fun, relaxed and memorable for everyone.
